When God Speaks – Are You Listening?

When God Speaks Are You Listening?

Most of us have a relationship of some type or another with God. For some of us, God is our best friend, in on everything we do in life. For others, though, God is just a passing acquaintance. Like a dutiful son or daughter, we visit God once a week at church, temple or synagogue. Then we leave what we consider to be God's house to spend time with our family and friends.

We listen for God's guidance, but our ability to hear God's words is blocked by life's many interruptions. We go about our daily lives wanting more out of life and wishing for a better relationship with God. But we do not know how to listen when God speaks to us. So, we turn to ourselves and others for the guidance that we need in our lives. And, when all else has failed, we turn to God.

But when we finally turn to God, we still have the same ways of listening to God that have kept us from hearing the guidance God has for us. So, we lose faith in God's ability to heal us and to help us, and we grow ever-distant from our Creator.

Many of us give up at this point, and become separated completely from our desire to know God. Others of us search through various religions hoping against hope that we can find God in one of them.

When God Speaks – Are You Listening? is for everyone who wants to know God better. This 8-hour power-packed program will help you learn to hear God's guidance in your everyday life. It will help you learn to walk hand-in-hand with God through the perils, problems and pressures of your life.

Taught by Rev. S. Suzanne Fisher, **When God Speaks – Are You Listening?** will help you strengthen your spirituality. It will help you develop an open relationship with God.

There is no one 'right' way to know God, only the way that is right for each of us individually. This program will help you understand that your way of interacting with God is unique and special, just as you are unique and special.

In **When God Speaks – Are You Listening?** you will learn about the blockages that keep you from being able to hear and interact with God. You will learn how to remove those barriers so that you can hear when God speaks to you.

Through lecture and dynamic interactive exercises, you will also learn how to see God in others, how to develop a healthy relationship with God, and how to turn Fear into Faith.





How to Sponsor a Workshop

Non-profit organizations such as churches, synagogues, temples, and community organizations may sponsor a **When God Speaks – Are You Listening?** workshop.

The workshop fee is \$75 per person. Of this fee, \$50 per participant is paid to the workshop facilitator, Rev. Fisher, and \$25 goes to the sponsoring organization. The sponsoring organization is responsible for providing the following:

1. A place to hold the workshop that will comfortably accommodate all participants. (The workshop space must have bathrooms nearby.)
2. Tables and chairs for all participants.
3. A healthy lunch for each participant.
4. Break time refreshments.
5. A wireless microphone and a sound system that can be heard well in the workshop space.

Each workshop must contain no fewer than 25 participants, and no more than 75 participants.

One scholarship for each 25 participants may be given by the sponsoring organization. At the discretion of the sponsoring organization, the scholarships may be offered free or for a reduced fee.

With over 20 years of experience in all facets of training design, development and presentation, Rev. Fisher is a dynamic Training Facilitator with highly effective training skills and methods.

In 1989, Rev. Fisher coordinated, produced and hosted a live, call-in, television talk show called "Workplace Forum" which addressed

tough issues relevant to today's work place. Rev. Fisher has also designed, written, developed and produced video and audio training programs that pioneered in using humor as a training vehicle to convey serious information.

Due to complications from an illness, the Interfaith Celebration Gathering was discontinued in 1996. It was re-formed on the internet in 1997 as a weekly message on God's love for persons who had suffered from chemical injury and who could no longer attend the church of their choice.
